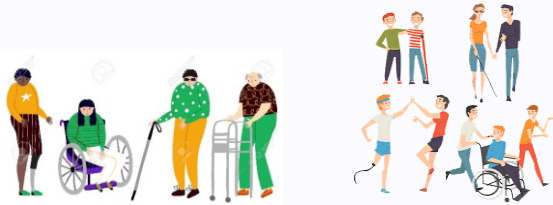


4. Specially Abled Persons

Our organization provides the following assistance to the differently abled person:

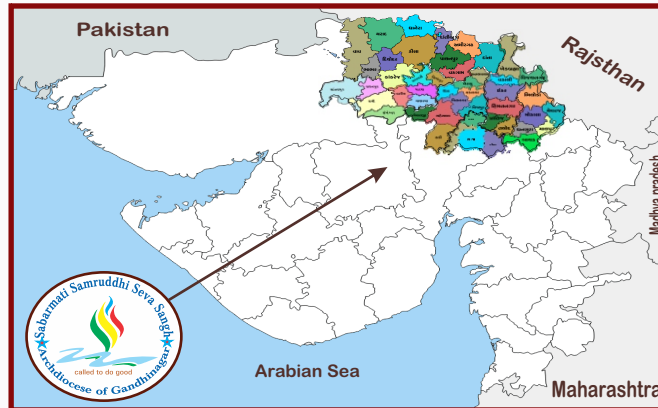
- Obtaining disability certificate to differently abled persons.

Programs in various fields

1. Health

Sabarmati Samruddhi Seva Sangh (SSSS) is working for the health of rural women and children for the last 20 years. It helps in reducing maternal mortality and child mortality, malnourishment in anemic women, children aged from 0 to 6 years, pregnant women and lactating mothers. It aims for safe and normal delivery in the hospitals, nutritious diet for mothers, children and adolescent girls. SSSS conducts regular awareness programmes on organic farming, gram sabha, organic fertilizers and medicines, growing of millets, preserving of traditional seeds and nurturing kitchen gardens. SSSS makes efforts to bring about change in the health sector by training the community educators and imparting that knowledge in their own village and neighbouring villages. SSSS conducts subject related competitions and camps. SSSS helps people to link with government schemes.



2. Empowerment

Since the beginning of Sabarmati Samruddhi Seva Sangh many programmes have been implemented in the field of empowerment. Women empowerment is vital. Believing in the equal rights and opportunities of women, SSSS has been taking steps to advance women empowerment by establishing women's cooperative societies. SSSS has helped 10 women's cooperative societies to be established as registered societies. SSSS works for the upliftment of women through savings and credit. SSSS prepares women to be entrepreneurs by imparting training in beautician, tailoring, and embroidery. Women are being uplifted through training in leadership, marketing strategy, government schemes and documentation.



Through the Frontex initiative, Indians who have illegally migrated or trapped in European countries are brought back to India with dignity. SSSS helps them to stabilize mentally and physically. SSSS through Caritas India provides facilities for business, education, health and livelihood. SSSS provides family counselling and awareness on legal migrations.



3. Migrant Programme

“To help the migrant families with overall development as individuals in our community.”

SSSS supports migrant workers and their families with social security, rights, employment, healthcare, temporary shelter, education, and government benefits, etc.

- Advice on minimum wages and other facilities in employment.

- Correction in Aadhaar & Ration Card.
- Creating new documents like e-shram, e-nirman, Aayushman Card, ABHA Card
- Registration for government schemes.
- Assistance in employment.
- Information about the employee's minimum wages.
- Assistance in healthcare.
- Legal assistance.
